
Earthlink specialises in delivering quality personalised support for people with disabilities or barriers, to engage in their community.





It can be daunting figuring out how to 'bounce back' after a period of struggle or illness.

Having someone walk beside you, supporting and encouraging you; can be the difference between thinking about opportunities and actually following through with them.



Our work-based training program helps those who experience disabling obstacles to gain practical skills.

Find pathways and plans that can suit your abilities, preferences, strengths and experiences.



Facilitating meetings to collaborate multiple agencies that should or could be involved in effective support.

We can work with other supports to establish a personalised support and transition plan.



Wellness & Work Skills Training

Our 10 week training program consists of classroom activities for 2 days a week for 2 weeks, focusing on health, safety and personal wellness in the workplace.

This is followed by 2 days a week for 8 weeks work based learning, mentoring and on the job support in Earthlink's various units, including:

- Furniture repair
- Small motors
- Dismantling
- Retail
- Stock prep
- Recycling runs

Job Club

Job Club runs weekly as additional and regular support for you in finding employment or community opportunities, including:

- CVs & cover letters
- Career planning
- Job matching
- Confidence building
- Interview skills
- Personal reflection

Staff and mentors have personal experiences of the difficulties faced by people with disabilities, especially when seeking community opportunities



First Aid Certificate

Our 1-day registered and recognised certification course includes video and verbal presenting, interactive scenarios, and real life experiences.
